

Bold Path to a Bright Future Scholarship

\$1,000 Scholarships:

- Awarded to two Shelby County and two Darke County students for the 2023/2024 college academic year.
- Recipients announced on April 26, 2024.
- Check distributed shortly thereafter and made payable to the student. Award will be presented at the May 2024 Big Brothers Big Sisters Board Meeting.

Minimum Requirements to apply:

- Student must have maintained at least a 2.5 GPA throughout high school.
- Must be a high-school senior enrolled in a Shelby County or Darke County school.
- Must be or have been involved as a volunteer for Big Brothers Big Sisters in the last two years.
- Applicants must plan to pursue an associate's or bachelor's degree or Certificate in any field of study at an accredited two-or four-year college or university, technical school, or trade school.

Application Process:

- Part 1: Complete this application.
- Part 2: Two References (forms included): Teacher, guidance counselor, principal, and/or Community Service Coordinator (excluding Big Brothers Big Sisters)
- Part 3: Submit a typed, double spaced essay on why mentoring is important for the community. (500-word minimum, no more than 1,500 words) OR submit a 2 to 3-minute video. Must include factual information about the impact of mentoring as well as personal reasons for volunteering with a Big Brothers Big Sisters program.
- Submit no later than April 5, 2024
