A collaborative program with Sidney Middle School. 5th grade students attend seven sessions that focus on confidence while in the presence of positive role models.

**Opportunity School:** 

Opportunity School is geared towards students ages 16 and up. Students who transition to Opportunity School focus on obtaining credits required for high school graduation or after.

School-Based:

One-to-one mentoring that occurs during the school day at a specified time and location. School-Based programs operate in Shelby and Darke County. SC: Emerson, Longfellow, Northwood, Sidney Middle School, and Jackson Center. DC: Greenville, Versailles, Tri-Village, and Ansonia.

Community-Based:

Matches that go out in the community together and enjoy activities they both are interested in. These matches consist of an adult-aged Big Brother/Sister and child-aged Little Brother/Sister
